Dept for Transport continue their support of Modeshift as funding partners for ATA and STARS Education and we are now working together sharing data to develop a greater understanding of the travel demands of education establishments.

Dept for Education are working with Modeshift on consultation documents including, Sustainable Modes of Travel Strategy (SMOTS) and home to school transport documents to promote travel planning.
