Complete the TravelWise Week 'registration form' using the following link <u>Modeshift TravelWise Week registration form</u>

Once received, Modeshift will record details of your planned activities on the European Mobility Week website on your behalf to showcase all the activity that will be taking place across the UK.

You can register your participation right up until 30 September.



Plan and deliver your Modeshift TravelWise Week activities and initiatives

Remember to gather evidence from your activities that can be used for your TravelWise Week Awards application. This should include (but is certainly not limited to) the number of participants that take part in your activities, photos, quotes and endorsements from participants, and examples of resources.



Complete and submit a Modeshift TravelWise Week Awards application form.

The Application form link will become live on the Tuesday 1 October.

All Awards applications must be received by 11:59pm on Thursday 31 October.

Shortlisted applicants will be notified by Friday 29 November and invited to attend the Modeshift National Conference which takes place on Thursday 27 March in London.

Eligibility

To take part in the TravelWise Week Awards your organisation must be registered with Modeshift either as:

- 1. a Member (Public Sector/Corporate/Corporate Premium) of Modeshift
- 2. a registered site on the Modeshift STARS system

Activities/initiatives must meet the following criteria:

- Must be delivered during TravelWise Week (16-22 September).
- Must promote a behavioural shift towards sustainable and active modes of travel
- Must not encourage unlawful behaviour

Rules

By submitting a Modeshift TravelWise Week registration form, entrants will state an intention to carry out activities and initiatives during Modeshift TravelWise Week. To be entered for the Modeshift TravelWise Week Awards, entrants must also submit a Modeshift TravelWise Week Awards application form. Incomplete entries will not be valid for an award.

By submitting a registration form, the entrant accepts that they have read and understood the campaign rules, and that the information provided will allow Modeshift to upload your information to the UK section of the European Mobility Week website.

The Modeshift Executive Board's decision is final. The Modeshift Executive Board also reserves the right to reject a registration that does not comply with the requirements of the campaign.

Notes

For Modeshift STARS users any activity completed and evidenced will also count towards STARS accreditation purposes.
